Shirley's Household Tips

Under \$5.00 Beauty Tips with Household Items

Starting with the top of your body:

Agua Dulce Women's Club Youth Scholarship Application Criteria

The Agua Dulce Women's Club is offering scholarships of various amounts to graduating high school seniors meeting the following criteria:

The *minimum* requirements to be eligible for a scholarship are:

Graduating seniors, living in Agua Dulce *or* graduating seniors of a Women's Club Member (prior to January 31, 2006) attending a school outside Agua Dulce area regardless of member's residence.

Enrollment in a 4-year college, community college or vocational school in the fall of 2006.

Completion of the accompanying application.

Completion of an essay (2 page maximum) paying particular attention to the guidelines listed below.

Include a certified copy of your most recent GPA.

Obtain 2 letters of recommendation.

While GPA and school performance are factors in the selection process, these scholarships are not necessarily intended just for high academic performance. Please address the following topics in your essay: 1) future plans, ambitions and area of interest; 2) community involvement and leadership skills; 3) extracurricular activities at school; 4) hardships and challenges you have overcome. These factors will weigh heavily and should play prominent roles in your essay, describe them in detail.

In addition, your letters of recommendation should be from people who can attest to your qualities and background, particularly those that relate to the selection criteria. For example, a teacher, community leader, employer, etc.

In order to maintain anonymity for the selection process, do not include any identifying data in your application answers or essay (name, parent's name, address, etc).

Mail your Scholarship Application and supporting documentation and have it postmarked by April 21, 2007. Mail all documents to Agua Dulce Women's Club, Attention: Lee Jennings, Scholarship Chairperson, 33346 Chamizo Calle, Agua Dulce, CA 91390. Be sure to make copies of all these documents and keep for your records.

Upon receipt of your application and the accompanying documentation, the Women's Club will call to verify receipt of your application. If you do not receive an acknowledgement of receipt within 10 days of sending your information, please contact Lee Jennings at (661) 268-1464.

Scholarship Awards will be presented at each high school's Awards Ceremony. Payment of scholarships will be made upon receipt of proof of enrollment.

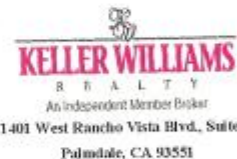
