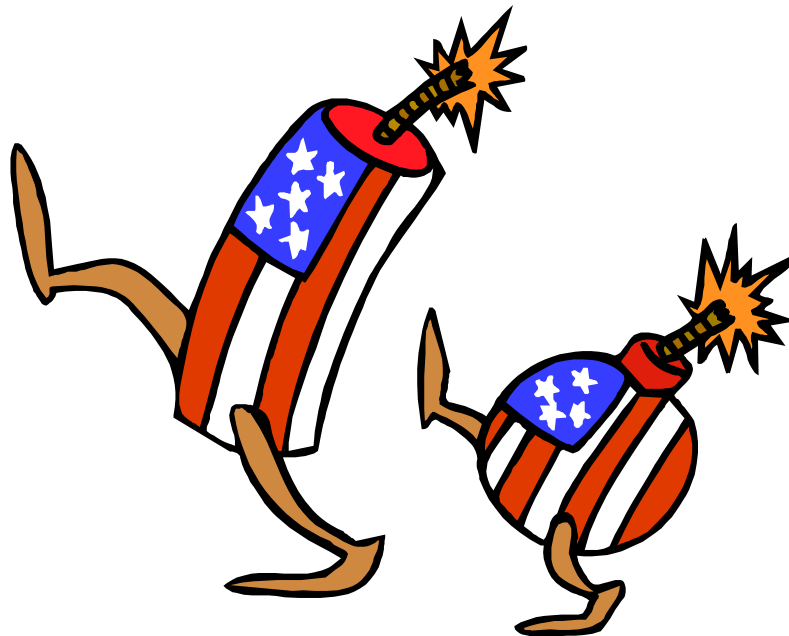

Shirley's Tips

Easy burned casserole cleanup: Put a softener sheet into the dirty casserole dish and fill with water. Let sit, and watch burned food slide right out.

To keep your lettuce fresh and crispy for up to two weeks: Burn two pieces of toast, wash and dry your lettuce, place in a seal-up bag. Break up two pieces of burnt toast and put in a bag with the lettuce. Seal and refrigerate. The carbon from the toast distributes through the bag, thus supplying oxygen. The lettuce stays fresh and doesn't have any burnt taste.

To relieve symptoms from a cold, make a big pot of your favorite chicken soup. Add fresh ground black pepper. I don't mean to shake it in...I want you to put in 1/2 cup of the pepper to 6-8 bowls of soup. The old tale that chicken soup cures the common cold - WRONG! It's the pepper combined with it.
