

*Agua Dulce Women's Club
Youth Scholarship Selection System*

A points system was set up by the Scholarship Committee in order to determine the highest eligibility for scholarship awards for each student based on the following criteria:

All categories could receive a maximum of 4 points, with the exception of the GPA.

Categories

GPA (grade point average)

Use actual weighted GPA

Student Activities

Dependent on the number of times and number of years the student has served

Community Service

Dependent on the number of times and number of years the student has served

Essay

Student should have addressed the following topics: 1) future plans, ambitions and area of interest; 2) community involvement and leadership skills; 3) extracurricular activities at school; 4) challenges you have overcome.

Tiebreakers

If there are more applications submitted than the Scholarship amount and there is a tie in the points, a tiebreaker will be needed. The tiebreaker will be based on the following:

- Child of a Women's Club Member = 1 point
- Women's Club Member in good standing (attends more than 60% of monthly meetings) = 1 point
- Women's Club Member is actively involved in the club (chairs committees or donates items for raffles) = 1 point

Discussion of student activities, community service and work experience will determine points awarded to each student.

Distributions of monetary awards are determined by discussion among the Scholarship Committee Members.
