

Charitable Activities: *Quarterly, Women's Club volunteers host parties for community children and/or community seniors and volunteers. All parties are held at the Women's Clubhouse. There is no charge to the children, seniors, or volunteers. These local, community, charitable programs are funded by the Women's Club.*

Fundraising Activities: *Monthly, Women's Club volunteers organize and operate specific fundraisers to support the Women's Club and their programs. These activities are held at the Women's Clubhouse or at a facility that will accommodate a larger attendance than the Clubhouse will allow. The activities may include Breakfasts, Luncheons, Dinners, Dances, Classes, Entertainment, Bake Sales, Vendor Booths, or combinations of the above. Ticket prices, rental space, opportunity drawings, food and beverage income and donations offset any expenses and proceeds benefit the Agua Dulce Women's Club and their Programs. Proceeds from Parade of Tables and Scholarship Luncheon will be designated for philanthropic and scholarship funds.*

Fundraising Projects: *Annually the Women's Club organizes fundraising projects. In recent years, Women's Club volunteers have donated their time in making a quilt. Tickets are sold throughout the year for a chance to win the quilt. Previously, the Women's Club members volunteered their time in publishing a cookbook. All income and donations offset any expenses and proceeds benefit the Agua Dulce Women's Club and their programs.*

Community Activities: *Annually, the Women's Club partners with other local organizations to host community-wide events. These activities are held at the Women's Clubhouse or at a facility that will accommodate a larger attendance than the Clubhouse will allow. Women's Club volunteers provide goods and services. Proceeds are split with the other organizations. Any proceeds the Women's Club receives benefit the Agua Dulce Women's Club and their programs.*

Member Activities: *The Women's Club funds specific activities for its members. Meeting programs, Membership Directory, Membership Luncheon, Bus Trips, and a Monthly Newsletter are provided to the membership for free or a nominal cost. The Women's Club solicits donations and advertising to cover any costs. All income and donations offset any expenses and any proceeds benefit the Agua Dulce Women's Club and their programs.*

Sponsorship: *The Women's Club sponsors Cub Scout Pack 51, Boy Scout Troop 51, and the Miss Agua Dulce Community Queens Scholarship Pageant. The Women's Club donates funds to these organizations, and ensures they have a meeting place and location for fundraisers and/or ceremonies. These youth organizations volunteer at many Women's Club activities.*

Community Recycling: *The Women's Club provides a recycling center on Women's Club property for our local community. The recycling center is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Proceeds from the recycling center benefit the Agua Dulce Women's Club and their programs.*

Clubhouse: *The Women's Club maintains and preserves an historic Clubhouse for community use. The Clubhouse is provided rent-free to youth and senior groups that host regular meetings. Nominal rental fees are assessed to community classes, community organizations, and individual member-sponsored rentals. Rental rates for non-members and businesses are assessed at a higher rate. All income and donations offset any expenses and any proceeds benefit the Agua Dulce Women's Club and their programs. In the past, specific fundraisers have benefited specific Clubhouse expenses.
